



Official Photographer(s)

The Official Photographers for the SkillsUSA—Arizona Championships will be student members from one of the Photography programs that is affiliated with SkillsUSA. The student(s) will complete the attached bid sheet and submit to the SkillsUSA—Arizona office via email, fax or mail by March 1, 2008.

SkillsUSA—Arizona will select up to three student(s) who will serve as the Official Photographers. All bids will be reviewed by a committee and the winning students will be notified by March 15, 2008.

The Official Photographer(s) must be responsible, dependable and on-time to all events listed below. SkillsUSA--Arizona will heavily rely on the recommendation from the student's Advisor in making a determination—your Advisor must sign the bid to be considered. The student(s) will have opportunities to capture SkillsUSA events that include students, parents, guests, contestants and many other aspects of the conference. The student(s) will be compensated, receive photo credit and a copy of printed publications of runs over 100 copies.

Days/Dates:	Monday, April 28 - Tuesday, April 29, 2008
Job Description:	Visit all major conference events as identified below. Obtain digital photographs that can be used for future publications.
Equipment:	Student(s) can use their own 8MB (or higher) digital camera or will use the SkillsUSA camera.
Pay Rate:	\$175 for 2 days of work.
Photo Credit:	SkillsUSA will retain the rights to all photos, but will include photo credit for the student in all publications. The student(s) will receive complete copies of all photos or of those desired.
Photo Types:	Group shots, individuals, students in contests using tools, students carrying tools, teachers, groups of teachers, staff, action photos, staged photos
Responsibilities:	Must be available on Monday, April 28 and Tuesday, April 29. Working hours will be 8AM to 8PM on April 28 and 7AM to 9PM on April 29. Lunch will be provided.
Lodging:	SkillsUSA will pay for lodging if the student(s) are not already staying with their own school. The student(s) will be housed with one to two other SkillsUSA members who are attending the conference or can choose to stay at their own residence (Phoenix metro area only).
